The timestamps for the various files produced by the ELAN export must share a common temporal origin.			
In a first attempt, absolute timestamps will be tried, checking whether ELAN accepts that.

Absolute timestamps do not work with ELAN.

Now all files are synchronized to the earliest timestamp found, fixing a bug previously present here (see r2201 in particular) and this is released as version 1.7.2 (see revision r2209).
